Things you could do:

- Commit to pray for a specific time every day/week.
- Use the national news or a newspaper to inform your prayer every day.
- Get info online/post from missions like : Open Doors, Barnabas Fund (persecuted church) or our International partners: Fountain of Life (Pinnintys), Good Rock (Jacqui Shurr), World Horizons (Coates & Hannah), Uganda church & village (Pastor Joshua), Israel and the Middle East etc.
- Call these international partners once a month and ask them what they need prayer for.
- Ask your group/community if you can be an international rep for the group and bring things to them for prayer on a regular or occasional basis.
- Be part of my team to plan International Month (September 2016).
- Run a regular (fortnightly, monthly, weekly?) "internat.com" group in support of international mission.
- Find out all you can about George Verwer (pictured above) - online videos, books etc and be inspired and encouraged! (I can lend you an inspiring DVD of his life story)
- Read Dutch Sheets book, "Intercessory Prayer".
- Don't try and do everything but do something!
